



GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS & FAMILIES

1. When was Christ's Chapel Academy (CCA) established?

Christ's Chapel Academy opened its doors for the 2022-2023 school year. We are gearing up for our third school year, which is scheduled to begin with our first day of classes on Thursday, August 15th, 2024.

2. What grades will CCA offer?

We plan to offer Preschool (3 & 4 Year-olds) through 6th Grade for the 2024-2025 school year. Christ's Chapel Academy fully intends to expand our classes beyond 6th Grade—to include at least a class for 7th grade students—in Year 4; that is, for the 2025-2026 school year.

3. What is the school's relationship with Christ's Chapel Assembly of God?

CCA is a ministry of Christ's Chapel Assembly of God. Our Director is under the supervision of the Senior Pastor; both the Director and Senior Pastor are ordained ministers with the Assemblies of God.

4. Where will the school operate?

CCA will operate on Christ's Chapel Assembly of God's 13-acre campus at 3819 Turfway Road, Erlanger, KY 41018. Our primary points of contact are the school office phone (859-653-0112) as well as our Director's email address: tcrowder@christschapel.net.

5. Why another Christian school? Why now?

CCA views education as discipleship. We are passionate about educating students with academic excellence, while also instilling a biblical, Christ-centered worldview.

6. Is Christ's Chapel Academy accredited? If so, with whom?

CCA is pursuing accreditation with the Association of Christian Schools International, the largest accrediting body for Christian schools in the world.

7. How will Christ's Chapel Academy select teachers?

All full-time CCA teachers will have a degree from a recognized college or university, with an emphasis on the area in which they will be teaching. All teachers will be expected to obtain—and maintain— certification with the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) as a condition of employment with CCA. Also, all CCA teachers will be born again followers of Jesus Christ and serve as active members in good standing of a local, Bible believing church.

8. What sort of curriculum will Christ's Chapel Academy use?

CCA will primarily use Abeka Christian School Curriculum for our Preschool and Kindergarten classes. We will primarily use Bob Jones University Christian School curriculum for Grades 1-6. Any and all curricula will be pre-approved by our Director and the Christ's Chapel Academy School Board.

9. What is the Student-to-Teacher Ratio at Christ's Chapel Academy?

For the 2024-2025 school year, we anticipate that the number of students in each class will be between 6-12. It is possible that a class will exist outside that range, but it is our goal to keep class sizes manageable for all students and for all teachers.
